

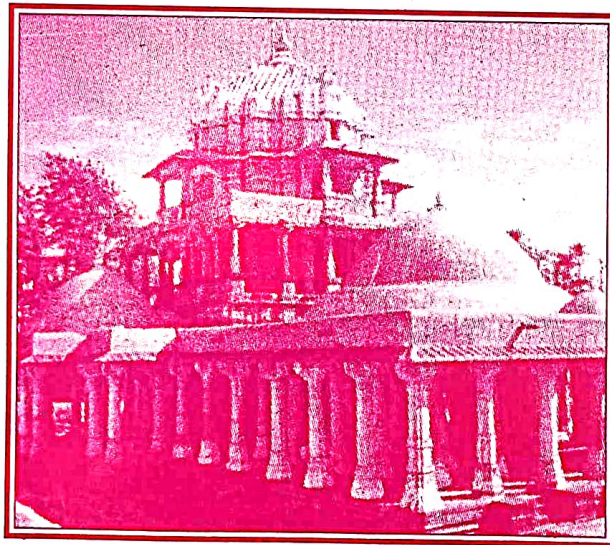

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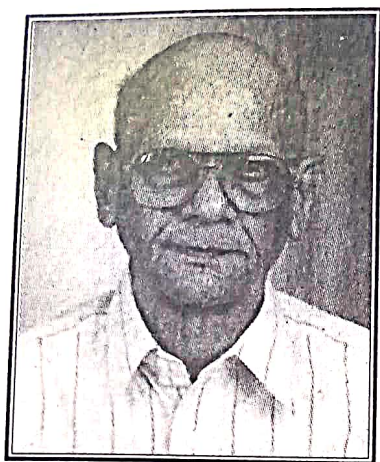

5. Life Time Achievement Honour from Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers. Besides, he held many positions of consultancy services and Company Directorships.

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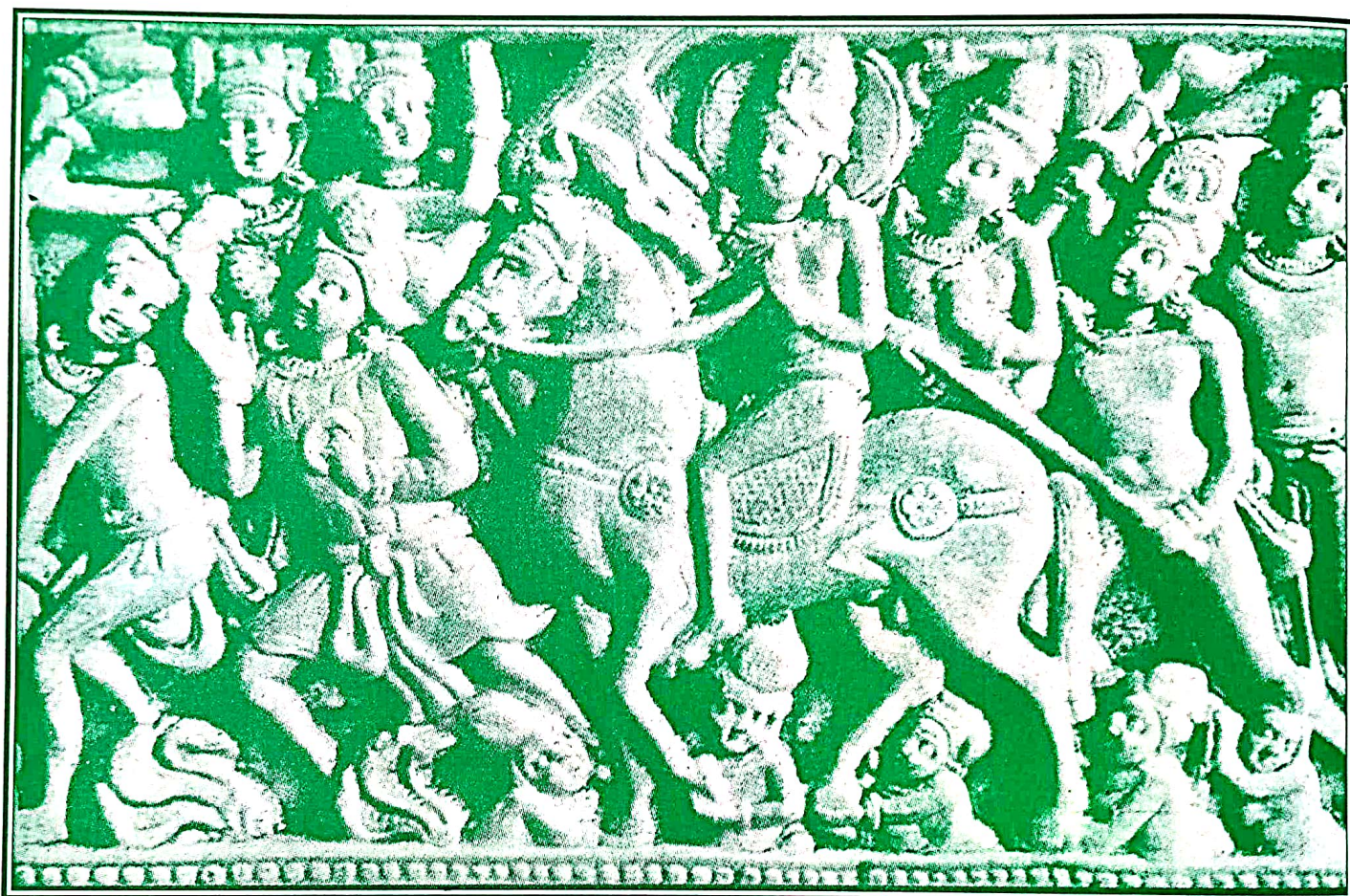
